





MDTP marks a successful second year of the Teacher Appreciation Package (TAP) program! The TAP program collaborates with local businesses and other strategic partners to provide discounts on goods and services in various industries to maximize the teacher's salaries. This year, we hosted two Teacher Appreciation Weeks in which discounts were available to all Arizona teachers who presented teaching ID! 

Along with this, **12** teachers and **500** students were impacted in total.






